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YOU NEED TO KNOW

Listed below is course information of interest to you as a prospective student at Steven Papageorge Hair Academy D.B.A. Mac Daniels Beauty School.

Employment Opportunities: Most recent information states that there were 6.33 jobs available for each new licensee*. Opportunities include beauty salons, large department stores, self employment, beauty product sales, platform artists.

Compensation: \$35,000 to \$50,000 is the average salary for experienced workers with a cosmetology license. The two most common forms of wage compensation are guaranteed salary and commission. Compensation increases depending on the development of new, retained, and request clients.

Physical Demands: Light lifting of 10-25 pounds is involved. You must be prepared to stand for long periods of time. Use of your arms, hands, fingers, hearing and sight senses are necessary**.

Safety Requirements: During the course and in the salon environment, you may be required to wear disposable gloves for certain services that are performed. You will be sanitizing metal instruments. Requirements also include sweeping of hair to provide student/hairdressers and customer accident prevention. Knowledge of chemicals you work with is also required.

Licensing Requirements and Fees: Upon completing the necessary 1500 hours of training in a licensed cosmetology school, along with passing the final written and practical exam, you are issued a diploma. You are then required to successfully pass the State Board written exam. Fee for Continental Testing Service is \$190.00.

Licensing Exam Pass/Fail Rate: 94.12 of the students taking the cosmetology test administered by the State of Illinois in 2008 passed examination.

Course Completion Rate: 83.61 of the students scheduled to graduate in 2008 went on to graduate in 2008.

Placement Rate: 86.67 of students scheduled to graduate in 2008 have found jobs in the beauty salons or cosmetology related fields.
